

Nyuzenmachi Disaster Prevention Map

Tsunami Edition

Revised in March 2025

This map provides a summary of potential flood areas, inundation depth, evacuation sites, etc., in case of a tsunami wave of maximum scale based on the results of the Toyama Prefecture Tsunami Simulation Survey (FY2016), pursuant to the "Act on Regional Development for Tsunami Disaster Prevention". Also, the maximum flood area independently estimated by Toyama Prefecture is posted as reference information.

In a survey conducted by Toyama Prefecture, it is said that a tsunami of about 10.2 m can reach Nyuzenmachi in about 7 minutes. Although actual tsunami waves may not necessarily result as expected, please use this information as a guide for your evacuation.

Audio Hazard Map

With the Audio Hazard Map (Uni-VoiceBellnd Apps), users can listen to disaster prevention information for Toyama Prefecture. Additionally, you can receive weather information for your current location, hazard map details, the locations and routes to the nearest evacuation sites/shelters, as well as push notifications for weather warnings and evacuation information.

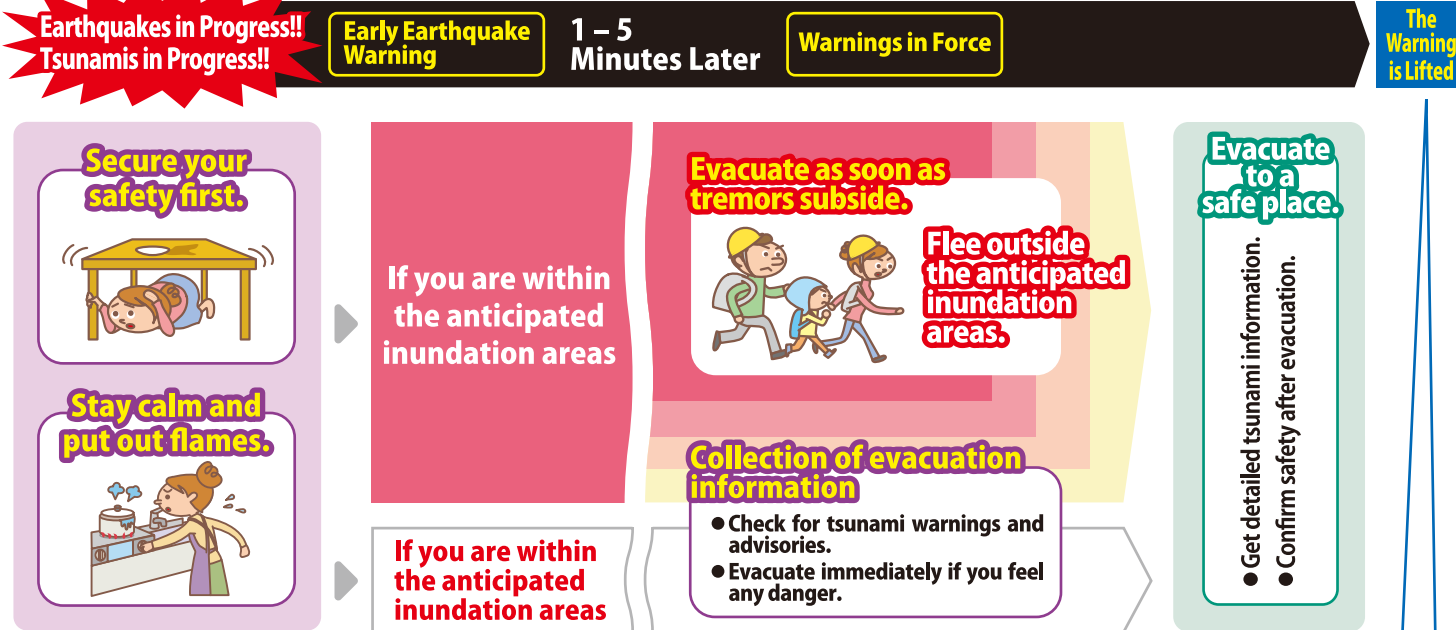
Audio Hazard Map Toyama

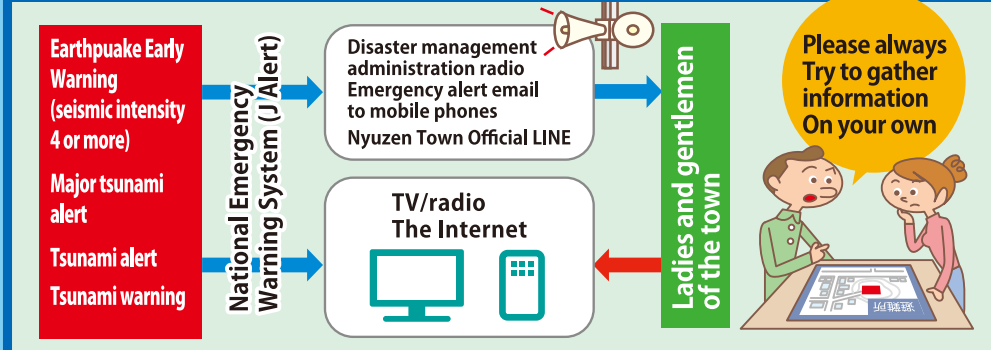
How to Evacuate from Tsunamis

During earthquakes, the displacement of the seabed ground causes the seawater to move vertically, resulting in tsunami waves. Evacuate as soon as you feel a tremor, not after tsunami waves arrive.



Note: Large tremors from earthquakes and subsequent rainfall may cause cliff collapses in landslide-alert areas. When evacuating, you are advised to keep safety in mind.

Types of Tsunami Warnings and Advisories (Tsunami Prediction Zone: Toyama Prefecture)

Type	Expected tsunami height		Actions you should take
	Numerical values	Expressions in the case of a huge earthquake	
Major Tsunami Warning	Over 10 m 10m 5m	Huge	• People who live along coastal areas and beside rivers should evacuate immediately to a safe place such as higher ground.
Tsunami Warning	3m	High	• Because the tsunami waves will come repeatedly, please do not leave the safe place until the tsunami alert is canceled.
Tsunami Advisory	1m	—	• People who are in the sea must come out of the sea immediately and move away from the coast.
			• Do not enter the sea or approach the coast until the tsunami warning is lifted.

• If the epicenter is close to land, the tsunami alert may be too late for the arrival of the tsunami waves.
• Remember the motto, "Evacuate if there is a tremor" and evacuate to a more secure place.
